Fine Motor Skill of the Month:

(4's and 5's)

Fine motor skills are developed gradually with repeated practice, and one of the wonderful things about fine motor development is that most of it can be done through play and ordinary daily activities.

Folding and Spooning

- Most children can fold things before they can fold paper.
- Demonstrate how to open and close a magazine. Describe as folding it together.
- Next show how to fold napkins, towels, socks and allow your child to practice.
- Work towards folding paper. Make a paper fan.
- Let your child spoon solids such as gravel, sand, salt, and small buttons into various containers.
- Practice spooning liquids. You can add food coloring to the water so it can be easily seen.
- Let the children spoon things like applesauce, raisins, and dry cereal.
