### Fine Motor Skill of the Month:

(4's and 5's)

*Fine motor skills are developed gradually with repeated practice, and one of the wonderful things about fine motor development is that most of it can be done through play and ordinary daily activities.*

#### Shaping and Fastening:

- The child should try pounding, squeezing, pushing, pulling and rolling clay.
- Make bread or cookies and let them knead and shape the dough.
- Practice buttoning, zipping, and snapping clothes.
- Have dolls and doll clothes for children to practice zipping, buttoning, and fastening.
